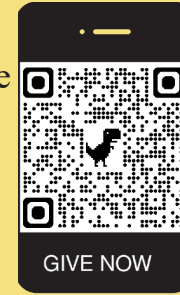

Persecuted Church: Turkey -

The gospel spread throughout what is now Turkiye in the first century, and the region remained under Christian rule for centuries, beginning in the fourth century. Now, however, fewer than 1 percent of Turks are Christians. Turks are proud of their nation, which has seen rapid industrial growth and modernization. Unfortunately, Islam is considered by most Turks to be part of their national identity; it is hard for them to imagine leaving Islam even if they know little about its teachings and do not practice its tenets. Christians in Turkiye have limited freedom of worship. While there are few Turkish churches, believers boldly share Christ with their countrymen. Ongoing changes in Turkiye's government have limited missionary activity and increased pressure on the small Christian community. persecution.com

- Pray for Christians serving the nearly 4 million refugees from Syria, Iraq and Iran.
- Fewer than 1% of Turks are followers of Christ. Use Matthew 28:19-20 to pray for the spread of the gospel in Turkiye.
- The Turkish government has deported many missionaries. Pray that local believers will boldly proclaim the gospel.
- Pray that followers of Christ in Turkiye will remain faithful despite pressure from authorities or family members
